San Diego-based Trigild has been appointed receiver for six residential and hospitality projects in the West, representing more than \$80 million in defaulted mortgages, says Bill Hoffman, the company's founder and president. The company's receivership team will oversee 59 units of a 104-unit condo conversion project in San Bernardino; a 56-unit apartment complex in Tempe, Ariz.; a 118-unit residential development Fresno; and an apartment complex in Las Vegas. Trigild also was appointed receiver and management company of the 68-room La Quinta hotel in Phoenix and receiver of a non-franchised, 88-room hotel in Ardmore, Okla.
